Section 10.13 of S.L. 2015-241

- HS juniors that are not deemed Career and College Ready will be required to participate in remediation during their senior year
- The CCs are responsible for:
 - Determining the criteria for CCR
 - Developing the curriculum
 - Developing and delivering the professional development
 - Data collection/analysis
- High Schools deliver the content

Implementation Timeline

- Three year rollout
 - Phase I 2016-17 optional
 - Phase II 2017-18 optional
 - Phase III 2018-19 mandatory state-wide

Eligibility Criteria

- Phase I Determined by the local partnerships
 - ACT score below benchmarks for math (22) and English (18)
 - HS GPA ranges from 2.7-2.75
 - Grade received or expected to receive in NC Math III
- Phase II Narrow eligibility criteria
- Phase III Further narrow eligibility criteria across models

Phase I Models

- English
 - Stand-alone course
 - Course resides in the Virtual Learning Community (VLC)
- Math
 - Embedded
 - Stand-alone course
 - NROC EdReady math course
- Reduced Dev Ed footprint
 - What does success look like?
